

THE ORIGIN OF STEEPLECHASING

The first recorded steeplechase was in early 1752. when two Irishmen matched their hunters for a 4 1/2-mile scramble from Buttevant Church to the Church of St. Leger. The steeple at St. Leger was used as a direction guide and winning post.

From Ireland, steeplechase fever spread quickly to England, where organized hunt clubs took up the sport and gave it a place to grow. By the 1830s, steeplechase racing was second to none on English hunt programs.

Meanwhile, back in the colonies, people such as Lord Thomas Fairfax, who owned 5 million acres in Virginia, and George Washington, who kept a kennel of hounds at Mount Vernon, became interested in fox hunting. Fascination with the sport continued to spread with the formation of American hunt clubs in the early 1800s.
